

Get your adventure on!

Troop 17 is planning to "Ride the Rapids" of The Mighty Kennebec River in northern Maine, Sat. June 30 - Sunday July 1. The Kennebec River provides world-class wilderness whitewater thrills for the most spectacular adventure in New England! This is a fantastic opportunity for scouts and parents alike.

We will be working with Adventure Bound (AB) in Caratunk, ME. Located about half hour from the Canadian border, AB is Maine's only youth oriented whitewater rafting facility, serving families, youth groups, schools and scouts providing the adventure of a lifetime in a safe environment with a professionally trained and certified staff.

Due to the nature of this trip, this is no ordinary camping trip. The Kennebec is a dam controlled flow. This means that the Harris Station Hydropower Dam at the head of the river releases water daily to ensure the level of flow on the Kennebec. It also means that rafting is actually scheduled to coincide with the release. Due to these constraints, the scouts will not be cooking their own meals. Also, Adventure Bound offers some things not found on a typical scout weekend.

The Highlights:

- Ride the longest continuous stretch of whitewater in Maine, taking on Class II, III and IV whitewater!
- Enjoy the beauty of the deep north wilderness of Maine with pristine views and maybe even a bald eagle following your raft!
- Inflatable kayaks on every trip for paddling in the small rapids
- Float along side the raft for a unique swimming experience through the famous "swimming rapids"
- Enjoy the hot tub and swimming pool before and after the trip
- Challenge the indoor climbing wall on Saturday night
- Enjoy the great riverside barbecue
- Conclude your adventure with a professional photo and video presentation of your trip
